Points to Cover

1. Introduce the project

- Introduce the website.
- Walk through Greener Green's mission.
- Show how to seamlessly transition between the AT & Platform, and navigate the website efficiently.

2. Present the digital tools

- **Assessment Tool (AT)**
 - Talk about the AT, emphasizing the need for such tools & collaboration among schools.
 - Introduce the 4 modules.
 - Show how, when you click "no" during the assessment, the system provides you with suggestions on how to improve.
- **GG platform**
 - Highlight the importance of the GG platform, which recommends modules based on assessment answers. Use one of the modules to illustrate this.
 - Explain module structure:
 - content organization in sections & subsections;
 - type of content (video, presentation, text, case studies, exercises);
 - quiz at the end of every module.
